

1999 PINEAPPLE OUTPUT 6 PERCENT HIGHER

Hawaii's 1999 pineapple production is estimated at 352,000 tons, 6 percent higher than 1998. According to the Hawaii Agricultural Statistics Service, fresh sales of 122,000 tons were 10 percent higher than 1998. Processed utilization, totaling 230,000 tons, was 4 percent higher than a year ago.

Total area remained unchanged at 21,000 acres. Weather conditions were mixed in 1999. While one island reported near normal rainfall which helped increase yields, another island experienced the driest conditions in decades which caused planting delays and lower yields.

The equivalent farm value of the 1999 pineapple crop is estimated at \$98.5 million, 6 percent higher than 1998. The farm gate price of pineapple utilized as processed fruit was pegged at \$126 a ton. Fresh market sales averaged \$570 a ton, 1 percent lower than a year ago. Market conditions for fresh fruit were reported to be favorable. However, markets for processed products were lower due to higher supplies from Asia.
