Crop condition

The advent of summer and its warmer temperatures have accelerated crop growth. Fields at the lower elevations, where temperatures are warmer, experienced less ideal growth compared to fields at the higher elevations.

May review

Statewide sales totaled 1.1 million pounds in May, up 13 percent from April. Average yield improved to 24,000 pounds per harvested acre during May as most of the crop continued to show good crop growth under sunny skies,

moderate temperatures, and adequate irrigation.

Farm prices averaged 21.5 cents per pound in May, down 11 percent from April.

Outlook

Harvested acreage is expected to decrease in the coming months. The forecast of harvested acreage for June is 43 acres, down 7 percent from May. Farmers are expected to harvest 42 acres in July, a 2-percent decrease from June.

The seasonal advent of warmer temperatures is expected to lower yields.




Crop highlights

Snap Beans


Crop conditions varied from a few in poor condition to most in fair to good condition. Harvested acreage is expected to decline in the coming months.

Chinese Cabbage

Crop conditions were mostly good to fair for major plantings on Hawaii and Maui island. Spraying is minimizing insect and disease damage. Irrigation was generally heavy to maintain normal crop progress.

Romaine

Crop conditions varied from poor to good. Some fields were plagued by disease that have significantly affected crop growth. Other fields were in generally good condition with little evidence of disease.



Dry onion

Crop conditions remained fair to good throughout the State. For the most part, weather conditions have been favorable for growth. Harvested acreage will decrease substantially in June; mainly on Oahu.

Cucumbers

Crop conditions were good to fair. Warm temperatures, longer daylight hours, and generally dry conditions have aided crop growth. Harvesting will remain very active.

Sweet corn

Crop conditions and yields have been good. Some growers reported slow market conditions. Irrigation remains heavy in most areas.
