## Crop condition

Crop conditions varied as the sunny skies and warm temperatures of summer were less than favorable for crop development. Insect pressure was higher in some areas due to the warmer weather. Timely spraying, however, was keeping overall losses to a minimum. Irrigation was heavy in all areas. Most fields were in fair condition was some fields in good condition.

## August review

Statewide sales totaled 1.2 million pounds in August, up 7 percent from July. Average yield increased to 24,800 pounds per harvested acre during August.

Farm prices averaged 18.7 cents per pound in August, 9 percent higher than in July.

#### Outlook

Harvested acreage is projected to decline 13 percent in September to 41 acres. Harvested acreage is expected to decline further in October to 36 acres, a 12 percent drop from September.

Head cabbage production is seasonally low during the late summer months of August and September.




Crop conditions, acres harvested, and acres intended to be harvested for selected vegetables, State of Hawaii.

#### **Snap Beans**


Plantings remained in fair to good condition. Some insect and disease damage was noticed in fields. Most of the drop in acreage expected in September will occur on the Big Island.

## **Chinese Cabbage**

Crop conditions were generally fair as vairable weather was less than ideal for crop growth. An increase in disease was noticed in some fields. Overall, regular spraying has minimized losses due to insects and diseases.

#### Romaine

Mature fields were in fair to mostly good condition. Irrigation has been heavy to combat the dryness. Sunny skies have resulted in rapid head development. Insect and disease incidence was light.



### Dry onion

Most fields were in fair condition. Yields have decreased mainly due to weather conditions. Overall quality remains good, but size appears to be smaller.

#### **Cucumbers**

Crop conditions were fair to good in most areas. Irrigation has been heavy. Losses due to insects and diseases have been light.

## Sweet corn

Crop conditions were fair to good. Sunny skies have been beneficial for crop development. Irrigation has been heavy due to light rainfall. Some fields are reportedly not receiving sufficient irrigation and may experience lower yields.
