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Hawaii 2025 Aquaculture Sales Increase to \$56.6 Million Dollars

Hawaii 2025 aquaculture sales totaled \$56.6 million dollars, up 7 percent from 2024 sales of \$53.0 million dollars, according to USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service. Shellfish contributed \$30.8 million and accounted for more than half of total sales. The "Other" category comprised the remaining items and unpublished items with total sales of \$25.8 million. The peak number of hired workers on the payroll was 352 for 2025, as reported by the producers.
