Corn stocks in all positions on March 1, 2025 totaled 1.38 billion bushels, down 7 percent from March 1, 2024. On-farm stocks totaled 600 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 780 million bushels. The December 2024 - February 2025 indicated disappearance is 643 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on March 1, 2025 totaled 337 million bushels, up 1 percent from March 1, 2024. On-farm stocks totaled 140 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 197 million bushels. The December 2024 - February 2025 indicated disappearance is 208 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on March 1, 2025 totaled 24.0 million bushels, down 22 percent from March 1, 2024. On-farm stocks totaled 2.35 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 21.7 million bushels. The December 2024 - February 2025 indicated disappearance is 13.3 million bushels.
