Electronic Information and Data from USDA, NASS, Indiana Field Office

National & State Reports are available in several different medias.

The National Agricultural Statistics Service, NASS, provides meaningful, accurate, and objective statistical information and services for the United States, its agriculture, and its rural communities. NASS provides its services through a main Headquarters unit located in Washington, DC and in 45 State Field Offices serving all 50 states. The State Field Offices are operated under cooperative funding agreements with State Departments of Agriculture and/or land-grant universities.

Nationwide: About 400 National reports are issued by NASS every year with estimates covering about 120 crops and 45 livestock items. Each report is released on a fixed schedule according to an annual calendar of release dates. Strict security measures are maintained to ensure that no one gains premature access to the information.

Indiana: The Indiana field office issues about 60 reports annually. The semimonthly Indiana Ag Report is a consolidated report providing basic up-to-date State & National estimates. A weekly crop and weather report (issued each Monday, April through November) reports on crop progress and conditions. An annual County Estimates report, available in the spring, details county breakdowns on crops and livestock. The Annual Summary, published in the fall, is a summary of all information issued during the year with historical comparisons.
