

POULTRY AND OTHER LIVESTOCK

Total value of production from eggs was \$535.6 million in 2008, up 27 percent from a year earlier. The average number of layers at 24.1 million was 3 percent below 2007. The average rate of lay was up 1 percent from 2007, at 271 eggs per layer, resulting in a 2 percent decrease in total egg production during 2008. The average price received by producers for eggs was 98.5 cents per dozen compared with 76.0 cents a year earlier.

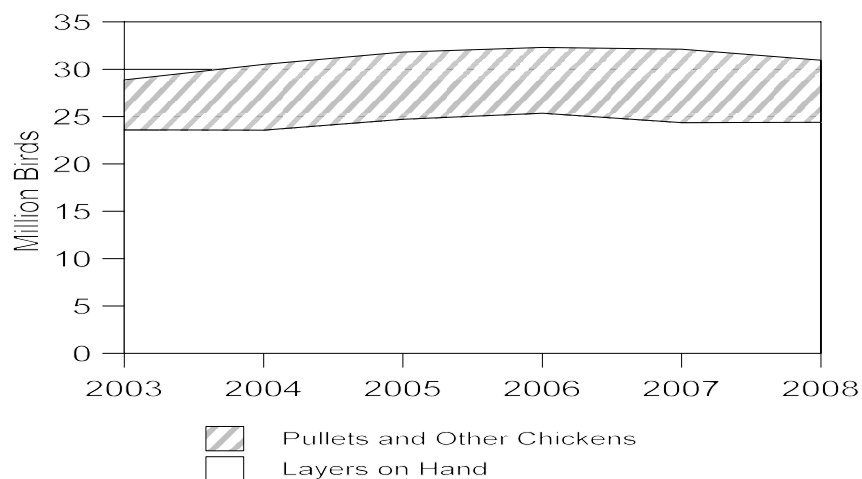

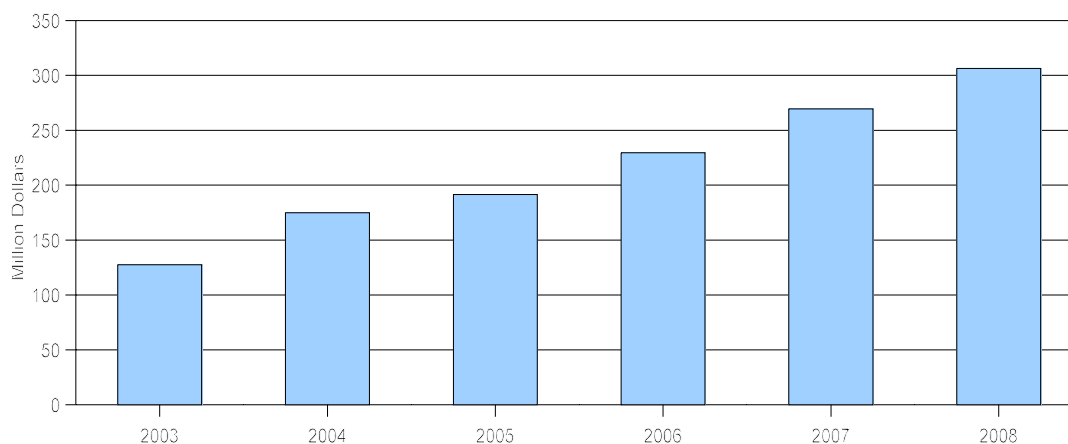
