

POULTRY AND OTHER LIVESTOCK

Total value of production from eggs was \$473.9 million in 2012, up 13 percent from a year earlier. The average number of layers at 24.9 million was up 7 percent from 2011. The average rate of lay was down 2 percent from 2011, at 273 eggs per layer, resulting in a 5 percent increase in total egg production during 2012.

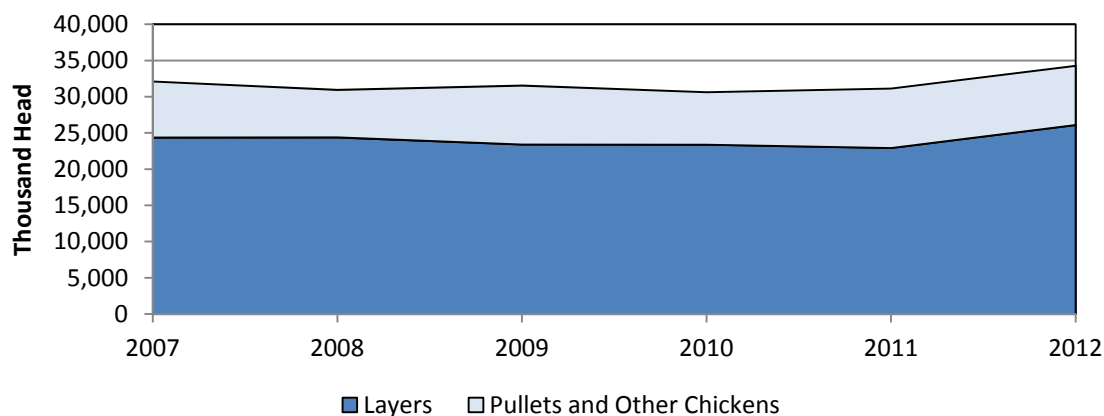

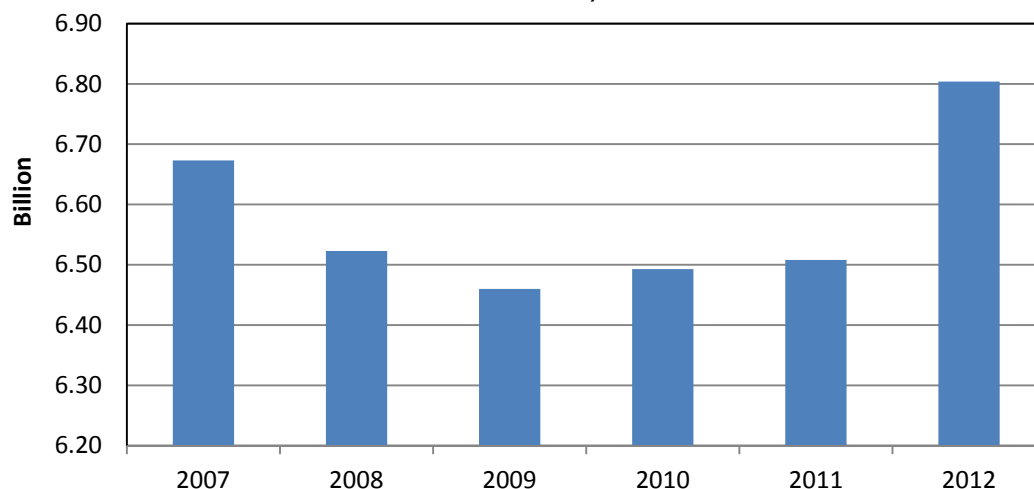

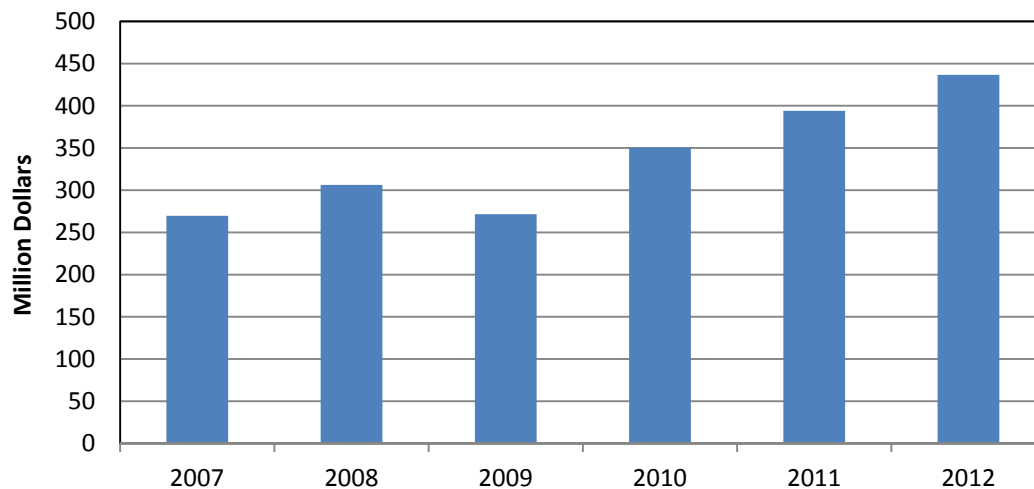
