

CAUSE OF EQUINE DEATHS, INDIANA 2001 OTHER CAUSES

One of the other conditions is Neurologic diseases. Neurologic disease is a general term for problems which affect the central nervous system. These can range from dummy foals, which is a result of circulatory dysfunction, to wobbler syndrome. Wobbler syndrome (equine spinal ataxia), is a result of improperly developed bones in the neck. These bones then cause damage to the spinal cord, resulting in the muscular incoordination that characterizes wobbles.
