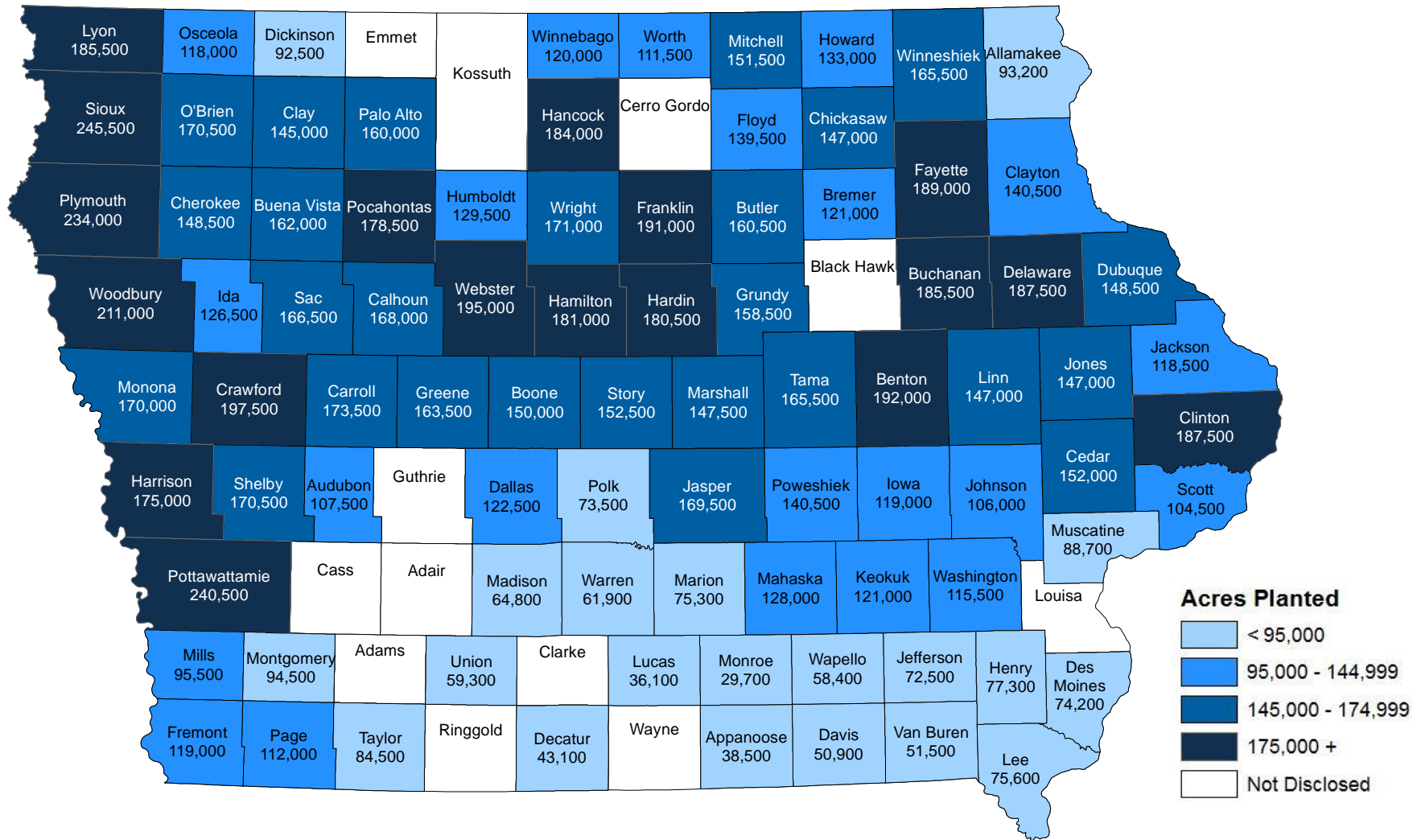


# Corn Planted for All Purposes – Iowa: 2023

## State Total: 13,100,000 Acres



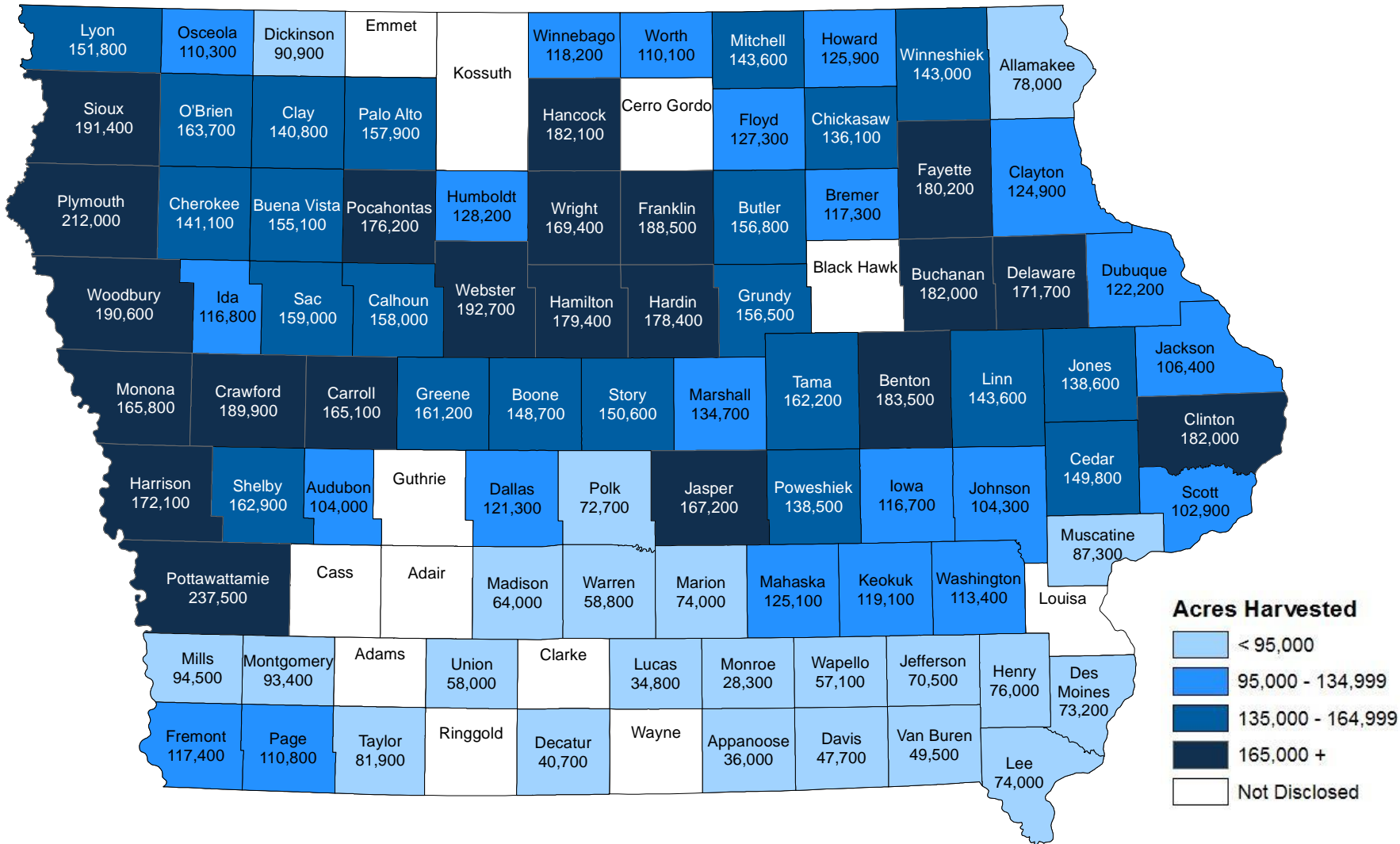

State Total: 12,550,000 Acres



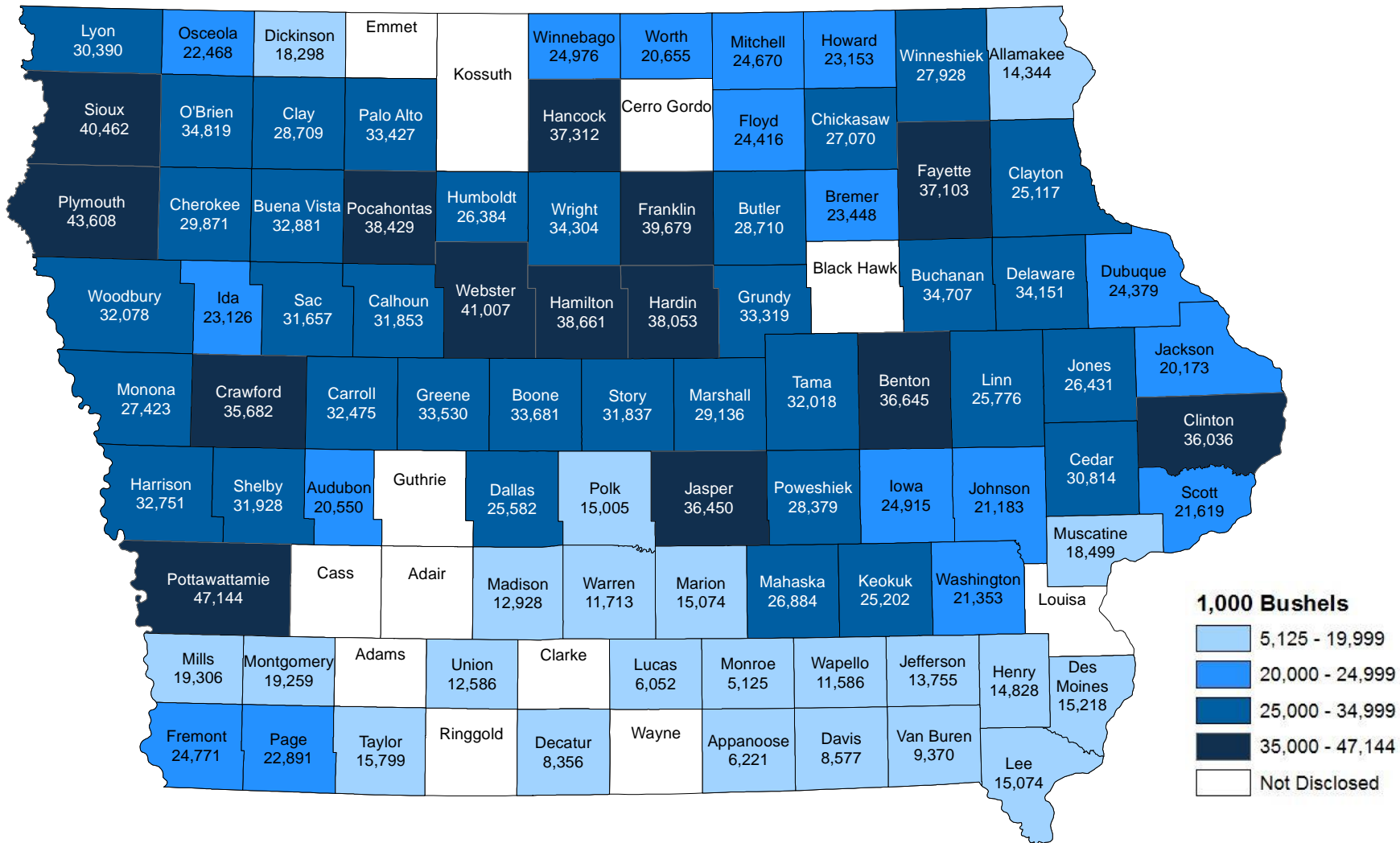

State Total: 2,522,550,000 Bushels



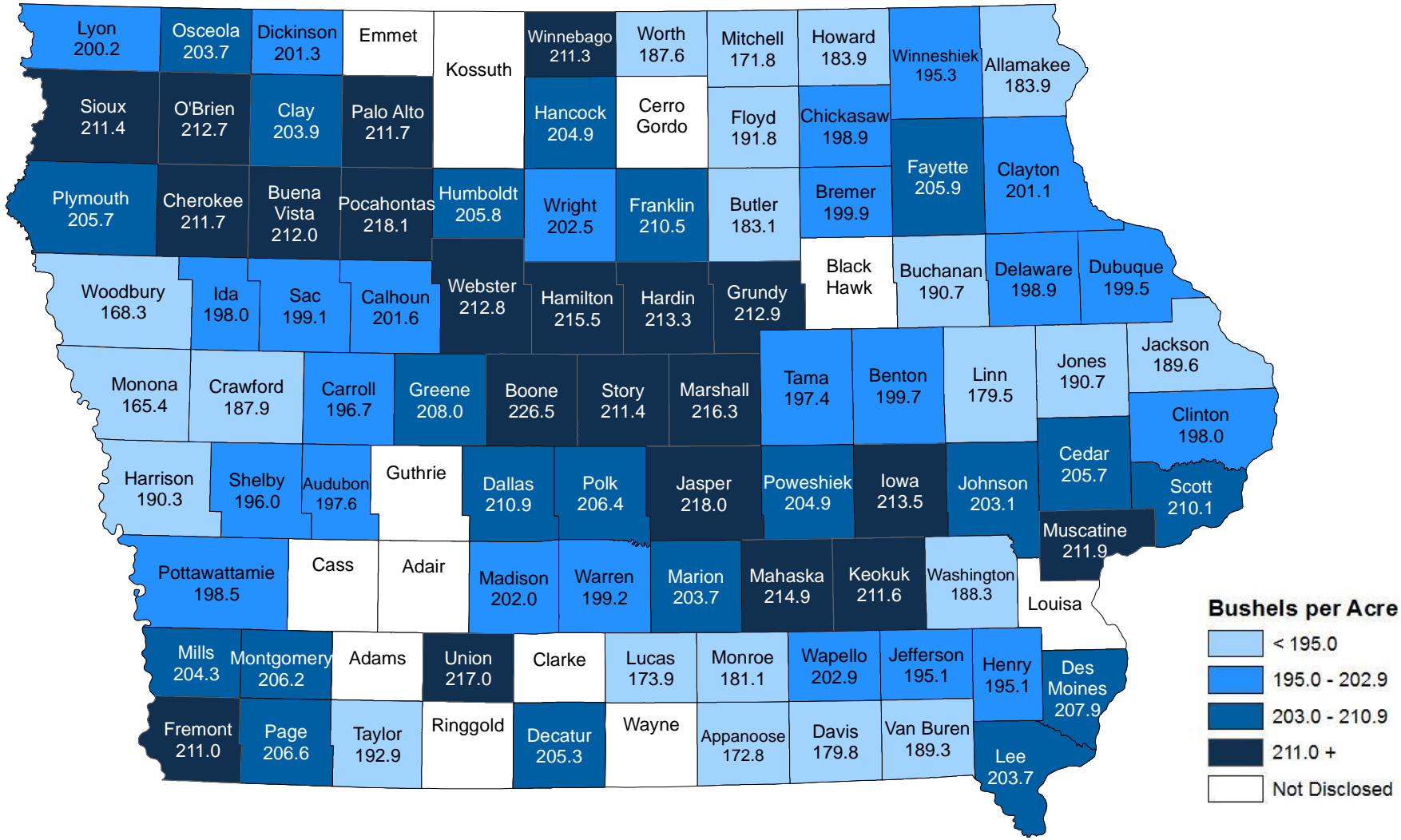

State Average: 201.0 Bushels per Acre



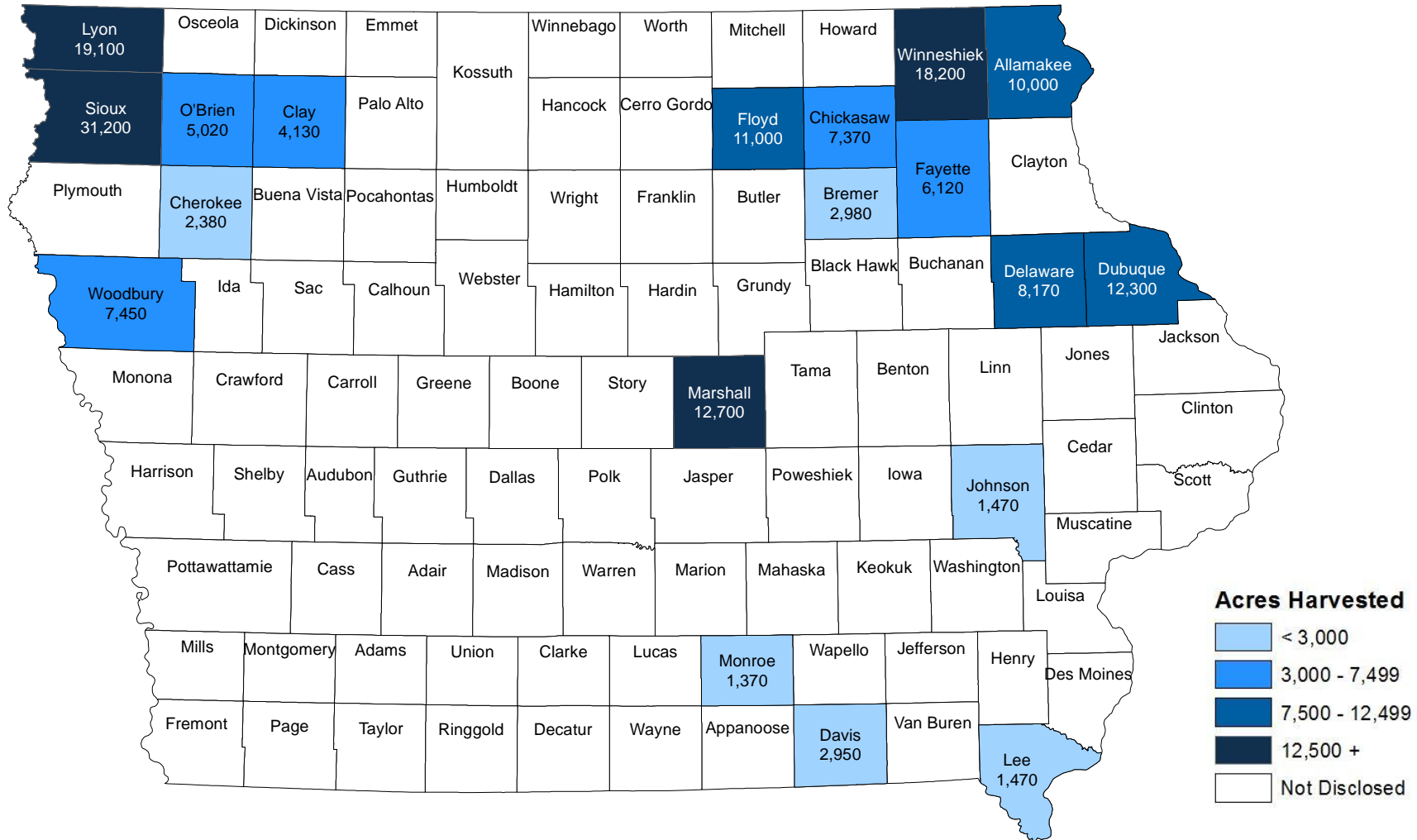

State Total: 380,000 Acres



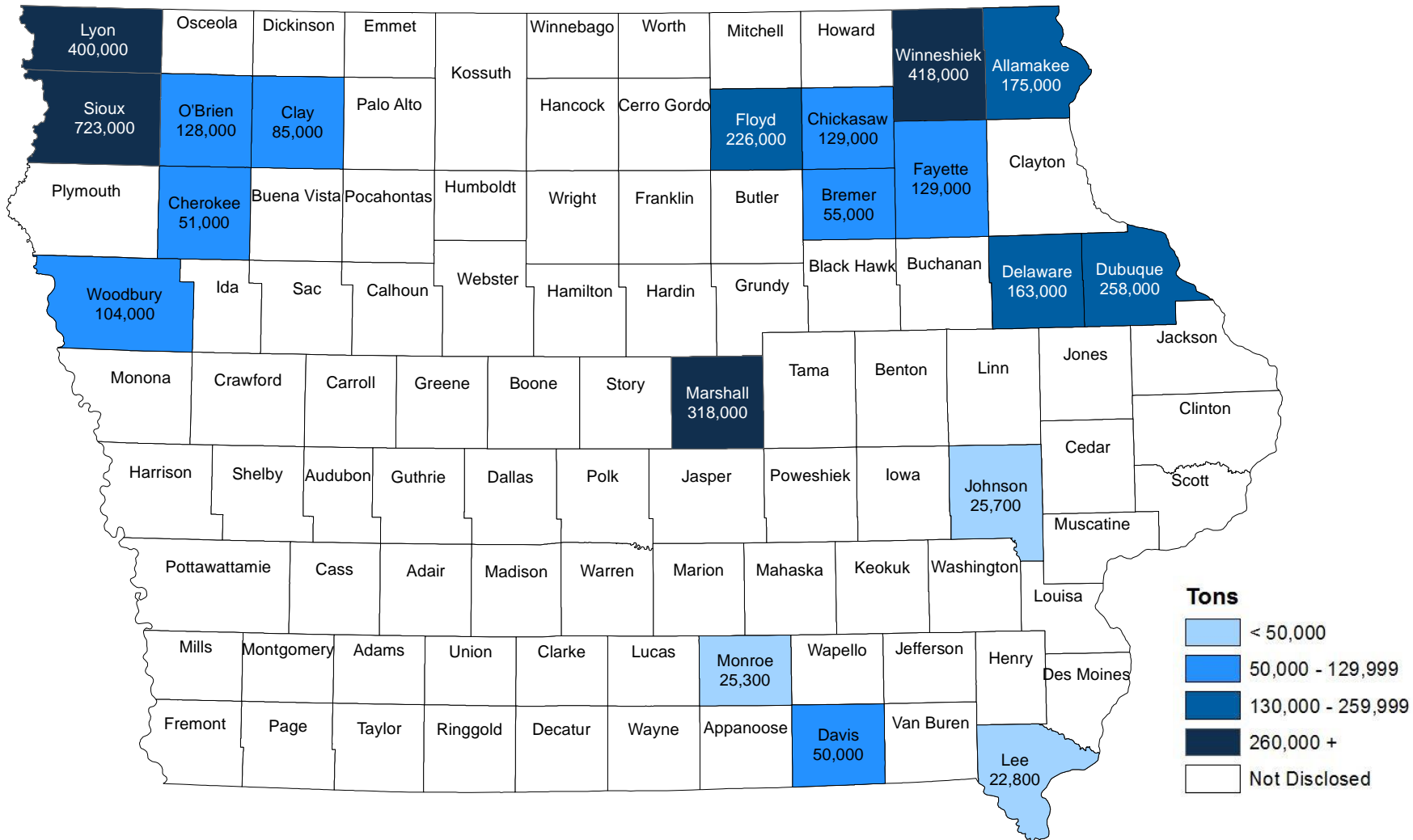

State Total: 7,600,000 Tons



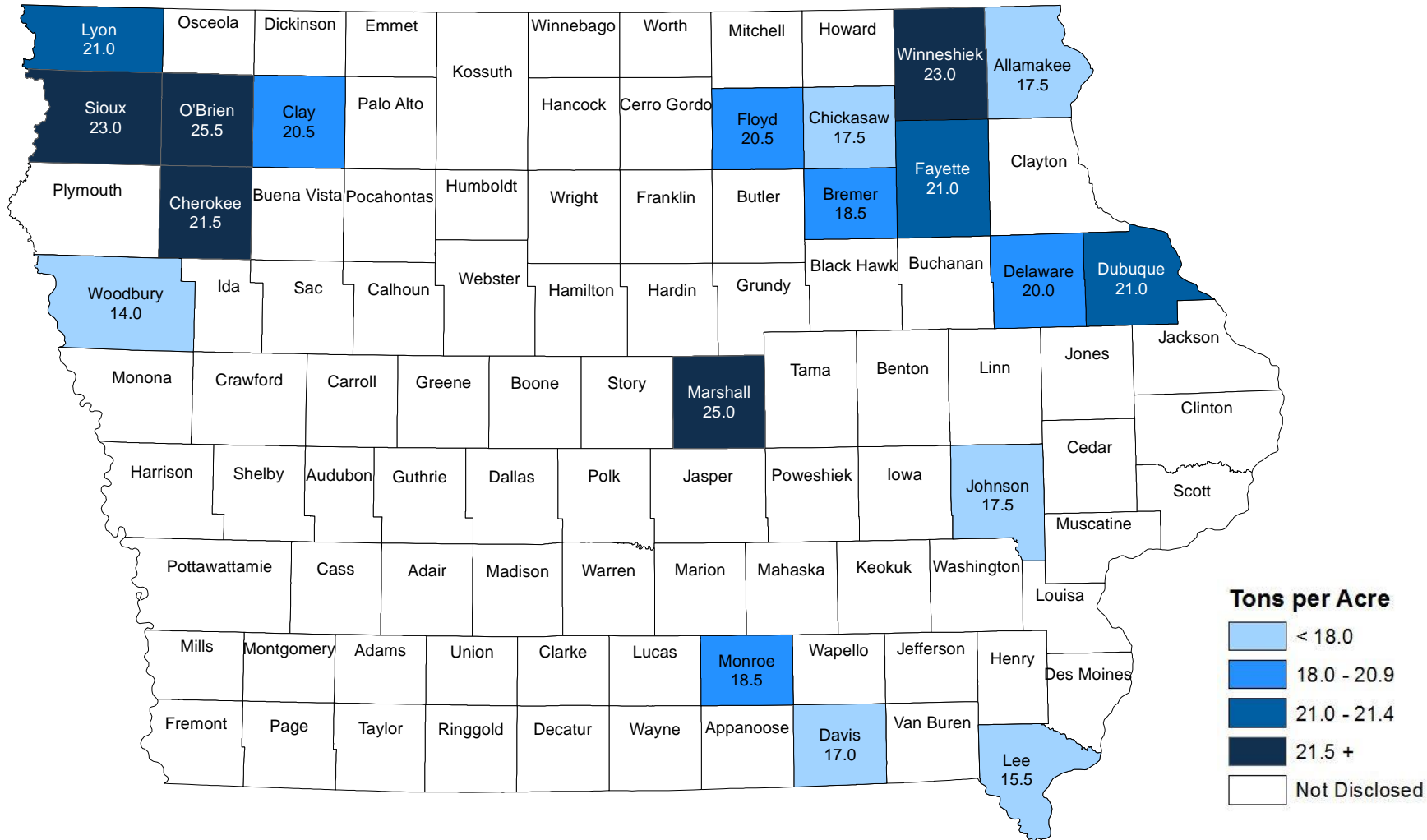
