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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 4, 2021 - For the week ending January 3, 2021, topsoil moisture supplies rated 14% very short, 29% short, 49% adequate, and 8% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 11% very short, 34% short, 52% adequate, and 3% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 5% very poor, 12% poor, 37% fair, 40% good, and 6% excellent.

Cotton harvested was 84%, behind 97% last year.

The next report will be issued January 25, 2021.
