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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 25, 2021 - For the week ending January 24, 2021, topsoil moisture supplies rated 21% very short, 34% short, 42% adequate, and 3% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 16% very short, 37% short, 46% adequate, and 1% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 7% very poor, 17% poor, 33% fair, 40% good, and 3% excellent.
