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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 30, 2023 - For the week ending January 29, 2023, topsoil moisture supplies rated 36% very short, 30% short, 33% adequate, and 1% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 44% very short, 34% short, 21% adequate, and 1% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 20% very poor, 27% poor, 32% fair, 19% good, and 2% excellent.

The next report will be issued February 27, 2023.
