KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. July 24, 2023 - For the week ending July 23, 2023, there were 5.3 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 8% very short, 23% short, 60% adequate, and 9% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 9% very short, 32% short, 55% adequate, and 4% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat harvested was 87%, behind 100% last year and 98% for the five-year average.

Corn condition rated 3% very poor, 7% poor, 32% fair, 45% good, and 13% excellent. Corn silking was 68%, ahead of 59% last year, but near 69% average. Dough was 24%, ahead of 18% last year, and equal to average.

Soybean condition rated 1% very poor, 10% poor, 31% fair, 48% good, and 10% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 59%, ahead of 48% last year, and near 55% average. Setting pods was 24%, ahead of 10% last year, and near 20% average.

Sorghum condition rated 3% very poor, 7% poor, 38% fair, 41% good, and 11% excellent. Sorghum headed was 20%, ahead of 11% last year, and near 17% average. Coloring was 6%, ahead of 1% average.

Cotton condition rated 1% very poor, 6% poor, 29% fair, 48% good, and 16% excellent. Cotton squaring was 88%, behind 95% last year, but ahead of 80% average. Setting bolls was 36%, near 38% last year, but ahead of 18% average.

Sunflowers planted was 96%, near 99% both last year and average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 8% very poor, 21% poor, 41% fair, 25% good, and 5% excellent.
