KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. February 26, 2024 - For the week ending February 25, 2024, topsoil moisture supplies rated 4% very short, 26% short, 67% adequate, and 3% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 8% very short, 33% short, 57% adequate, and 2% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 5% very poor, 8% poor, 30% fair, 50% good, and 7% excellent.
