## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. March 25, 2024 - For the week ending March 24, 2024, there were 6.4 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 10% very short, 35% short, 51% adequate, and 4% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 12% very short, 36% short, 51% adequate, and 1% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 5% very poor, 8% poor, 34% fair, 45% good, and 8% excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 7%.

Data for this news release were provided at the county level by USDA Farm Service Agency, KSU Extension Service, and other reporters across the State.
