KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 13, 2024 - For the week ending May 12, 2024, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 20% very short, 26% short, 43% adequate, and 11% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 22% very short, 30% short, 43% adequate, and 5% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 13% very poor, 22% poor, 34% fair, 28% good, and 3% excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 97%, ahead of 84% last year and 89% for the five-year average. Headed was 73%, well ahead of 48% last year and 43% average. Coloring was 1%.

Corn planted was 61%, near 57% last year, and ahead of 56% average. Emerged was 41%, ahead of 31% last year and 29% average.

Soybeans planted was 33%, behind 38% last year, but ahead of 26% average. Emerged was 13%, near 14% last year, but ahead of 7% average.

Sorghum planted was 7%, near 6% last year and 4% average.

Cotton planted was 18%, behind 26% last year, and near 20% average.

Sunflowers planted was 4%, near 1% last year and 3% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 8% very poor, 18% poor, 35% fair, 34% good, and 5% excellent.
