KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. June 3, 2024 - For the week ending June 2, 2024, there were 4.2 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 10% very short, 18% short, 57% adequate, and 15% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 14% very short, 27% short, 54% adequate, and 5% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 13% very poor, 21% poor, 32% fair, 30% good, and 4% excellent. Winter wheat headed was 97%, ahead of 90% last year, and near 95% for the five-year average. Coloring was 70%, well ahead of 29% last year and 30% average. Mature was 25%, well ahead of 1% both last year and average.

Corn condition rated 1% very poor, 5% poor, 30% fair, 55% good, and 9% excellent. Corn planted was 92%, near 88% last year, and ahead of 87% average. Emerged was 79%, ahead of 72% last year and 70% average.

Soybeans planted was 67%, behind 77% last year, but ahead of 59% average. Emerged was 46%, behind 57% last year, but near 42% average.

Sorghum planted was 35%, ahead of 28% last year and 25% average.

Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 6% poor, 27% fair, 41% good, and 26% excellent. Cotton planted was 84%, ahead of 66% last year and 72% average.

Sunflowers planted was 21%, ahead of 15% last year, but near 25% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 6% very poor, 13% poor, 32% fair, 42% good, and 7% excellent.
