KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 5, 2025 - For the week ending May 4, 2025, there were 4.7 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 9% very short, 27% short, 56% adequate, and 8% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 13% very short, 29% short, 54% adequate, and 4% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 5% very poor, 15% poor, 33% fair, 40% good, and 7% excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 87%, behind 92% last year, but ahead of 80% for the five-year average. Headed was 45%, behind 51% last year, but ahead of 26% average.

Corn planted was 50%, near 49% last year, and ahead of 43% average. Emerged was 24%, near 27% last year, but ahead of 18% average.

Soybeans planted was 23%, near 21% last year, and ahead of 17% average. Emerged was 3%, near 4% last year and 2% average.

Sorghum planted was 4%, equal to last year, and near 2% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 13% poor, 28% fair, 46% good, and 9% excellent.
