KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 19, 2025 - For the week ending May 18, 2025, there were 6.3 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 11% very short, 28% short, 58% adequate, and 3% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 12% very short, 29% short, 57% adequate, and 2% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 6% very poor, 14% poor, 31% fair, 43% good, and 6% excellent. Winter wheat jointed was 96%, near 99% last year and 95% for the five-year average. Headed was 84%, near 88% last year, but ahead of 71% average. Coloring was 7%, behind 21% last year.

Corn condition rated 3% very poor, 6% poor, 31% fair, 48% good, and 12% excellent. Corn planted was 73%, near 72% last year and 70% average. Emerged was 53%, near 51% last year, and ahead of 45% average.

Soybeans planted was 57%, ahead of 42% last year and 43% average. Emerged was 25%, near 22% last year, and ahead of 19% average.

Sorghum planted was 13%, near 12% last year and 10% average.

Cotton planted was 48%, ahead of 35% last year and 38% average.

Sunflowers planted was 4%, near 6% last year and 8% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 12% poor, 30% fair, 48% good, and 6% excellent.
