KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. June 30, 2025 - For the week ending June 29, 2025, there were 5.1 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 4% very short, 19% short, 67% adequate, and 10% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 7% very short, 24% short, 62% adequate, and 7% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 9% very poor, 15% poor, 28% fair, 42% good, and 6% excellent. Winter wheat mature was 94%, near 97% last year, but ahead of 88% for the five-year average. Harvested was 53%, well behind 76% last year, but near 56% average.

Corn condition rated 2% very poor, 6% poor, 26% fair, 55% good, and 11% excellent. Corn silking was 22%, behind 27% last year, but ahead of 15% average.

Soybean condition rated 1% very poor, 4% poor, 28% fair, 58% good, and 9% excellent. Soybeans planted was 90%, behind 97% last year and 96% average. Emerged was 82%, behind 89% both last year and average. Blooming was 13%, ahead of 6% last year, and near 10% average.

Sorghum condition rated 2% very poor, 5% poor, 33% fair, 53% good, and 7% excellent. Sorghum planted was 89%, near 92% last year and 91% average. Headed was 1%, equal to last year, and near 2% average.

Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 26% poor, 43% fair, 29% good, and 2% excellent. Cotton squaring was 12%, well behind 45% last year and 36% average. Setting bolls was 1%, equal to both last year and average.

Sunflowers planted was 84%, near 87% last year and 86% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 3% very poor, 8% poor, 23% fair, 53% good, and 13% excellent.
