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## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. July 21, 2025** - For the week ending July 20, 2025, there were 5.6 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 6% very short, 22% short, 65% adequate, and 7% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 10% very short, 23% short, 63% adequate, and 4% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat harvested was 97%, near 99% last year and 94% for the five-year average.

Corn condition rated 1% very poor, 8% poor, 27% fair, 47% good, and 17% excellent. Corn silking was 61%, behind 74% last year, and near 64% average. Dough was 24%, near 28% last year and 21% average.

Soybean condition rated 1% very poor, 6% poor, 29% fair, 53% good, and 11% excellent. Soybeans emerged was 95%, behind 100% last year, and near 99% average. Blooming was 51%, near 49% last year, and equal to average. Setting pods was 17%, near 15% both last year and average.

Sorghum condition rated 1% very poor, 4% poor, 30% fair, 50% good, and 15% excellent. Sorghum headed was 7%, behind 17% last year and 15% average.

Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 9% poor, 41% fair, 38% good, and 12% excellent. Cotton squaring was 66%, behind 84% last year and 82% average. Setting bolls was 20%, well behind 49% last year, and behind 26% average.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 3% very poor, 10% poor, 30% fair, 49% good, and 8% excellent.
