KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. July 28, 2025 - For the week ending July 27, 2025, there were 5.1 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 6% very short, 18% short, 64% adequate, and 12% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 9% very short, 20% short, 62% adequate, and 9% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Corn condition rated 2% very poor, 7% poor, 25% fair, 45% good, and 21% excellent. Corn silking was 77%, behind 83% last year, and equal to the five-year average. Dough was 36%, behind 45% last year, and near 34% average.

Soybean condition rated 1% very poor, 5% poor, 26% fair, 54% good, and 14% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 63%, near 62% last year and 64% average. Setting pods was 27%, near 25% last year and 29% average.

Sorghum condition rated 2% very poor, 6% poor, 29% fair, 45% good, and 18% excellent. Sorghum headed was 19%, behind 33% last year and 26% average. Coloring was 3%, near 6% last year, and equal to average.

Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 10% poor, 38% fair, 37% good, and 15% excellent. Cotton squaring was 85%, behind 95% last year, and near 89% average. Setting bolls was 27%, well behind 57% last year, and behind 39% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 9% poor, 26% fair, 50% good, and 11% excellent.
