KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. August 4, 2025 - For the week ending August 3, 2025, there were 5.7 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 6% very short, 19% short, 65% adequate, and 10% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 8% very short, 22% short, 61% adequate, and 9% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Corn condition rated 3% very poor, 9% poor, 26% fair, 44% good, and 18% excellent. Corn silking was 85%, behind 91% last year, and near 87% for the five-year average. Dough was 51%, behind 67% last year, and near 52% average. Dented was 4%, behind 9% last year, and near 8% average.

Soybean condition rated 1% very poor, 5% poor, 22% fair, 57% good, and 15% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 72%, near 75% last year and 76% average. Setting pods was 35%, near 39% last year, and behind 43% average.

Sorghum condition rated 2% very poor, 7% poor, 27% fair, 48% good, and 16% excellent. Sorghum headed was 36%, behind 55% last year and 43% average. Coloring was 6%, near 9% last year, and equal to average.

Cotton condition rated 0% very poor, 9% poor, 37% fair, 42% good, and 12% excellent. Cotton squaring was 95%, near 96% last year and 91% average. Setting bolls was 48%, well behind 70% last year, and behind 56% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 8% poor, 20% fair, 55% good, and 13% excellent.
