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KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. January 6, 2026 - For the week ending January 4, 2026, topsoil moisture supplies rated 12% very short, 32% short, 52% adequate, and 4% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 10% very short, 30% short, 56% adequate, and 4% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 2% very poor, 7% poor, 31% fair, 49% good, and 11% excellent.

The next report will be issued February 3, 2026.
