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## KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**MANHATTAN, Kan. June 1, 2026** - For the week ending May 31, 2026, there were 4.2 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 17% very short, 26% short, 50% adequate, and 7% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 19% very short, 29% short, 49% adequate, and 3% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 24% very poor, 31% poor, 30% fair, 14% good, and 1% excellent. Winter wheat coloring was 79%, well ahead of 50% last year and 39% for the five-year average. Mature was 30%, well ahead of 1% last year and 4% average.

Corn condition rated 2% very poor, 5% poor, 29% fair, 58% good, and 6% excellent. Corn planted was 85%, behind 91% last year, and near 88% average. Emerged was 67%, behind 72% last year, and near 70% average.

Soybean condition rated 2% very poor, 5% poor, 32% fair, 57% good, and 4% excellent. Soybeans planted was 75%, near 71% last year, and ahead of 65% average. Emerged was 57%, ahead of 49% last year and 45% average.

Sorghum planted was 26%, near 28% last year, and equal to average.

Cotton planted was 77%, near 81% last year and 76% average.

Sunflowers planted was 28%, ahead of 22% last year and 20% average.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 12% very poor, 19% poor, 30% fair, 34% good, and 5% excellent.
