KANSAS CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

MANHATTAN, Kan. July 27, 2026 - For the week ending July 26, 2026, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 12% very short, 32% short, 50% adequate, and 6% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 13% very short, 31% short, 52% adequate, and 4% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Corn condition rated 6% very poor, 11% poor, 29% fair, 42% good, and 12% excellent. Corn silking was 70%, behind 75% for both last year and the five-year average. Dough was 34%, equal to last year, and near 31% average.

Soybean condition rated 1% very poor, 6% poor, 29% fair, 55% good, and 9% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 63%, near 61% both last year and average. Setting pods was 32%, ahead of 26% last year and 24% average.

Sorghum condition rated 5% very poor, 14% poor, 34% fair, 36% good, and 11% excellent. Sorghum headed was 23%, ahead of 17% last year, and near 22% average. Coloring was 8%, ahead of 3% both last year and average.

Cotton condition rated 3% very poor, 11% poor, 31% fair, 38% good, and 17% excellent. Cotton squaring was 95%, ahead of 82% last year and 89% average. Setting bolls was 35%, ahead of 26% last year, but near 37% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 5% very poor, 15% poor, 30% fair, 42% good, and 8% excellent.
