KANSAS JUNE 1, 2023 GRAIN STOCKS

MANHATTAN, Kan. June 30, 2023 - Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2023 totaled 146 million bushels, down 20% from 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 38.0 million bushels are stored on farms, down 21% from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 108 million bushels, are down 20% from last year.

Wheat stored in all positions totaled 99.0 million bushels, down 45% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 4.80 million bushels are up 37% from 2022, but off-farm stocks of 94.2 million bushels are down 46% from last year.

Sorghum stored in all positions totaled 34.3 million bushels, down 53% from 2022. On-farm stocks of 4.75 million bushels are up 94% from a year ago, but off-farm stocks of 29.6 million bushels are down 58% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 33.7 million bushels, down 12% from last year. On-farm stocks of 10.5 million bushels are unchanged from a year ago, but off-farm stocks, at 23.2 million bushels, are down 17% from 2022.

Off farm **oat** stocks totaled 867,000 bushels.
