KANSAS SEPTEMBER 1, 2023 GRAIN STOCKS

MANHATTAN, Kan. September 29, 2023 - Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2023 totaled 76.6 million bushels, up 17% from 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 19.0 million bushels are stored on farms, up 23% from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 57.6 million bushels, are up 15% from last year.

Wheat stored in all positions totaled 251 million bushels, down 18% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 24.0 million bushels are down 21% from 2022 and off-farm stocks of 227 million bushels are down 17% from last year.

Sorghum stored in all positions totaled 16.7 million bushels, down 46% from 2022. On-farm stocks of 870,000 bushels are down 54% from a year ago and off-farm stocks of 15.8 million bushels are down 45% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 7.52 million bushels, down 16% from last year. On-farm stocks of 1.70 million bushels are down 6% from a year ago and off-farm stocks, at 5.82 million bushels, are down 19% from 2022.

Oat stocks stored in off farm positions totaled 1.39 million bushels, up 152% from a year ago.
