KANSAS MARCH 1, 2025 GRAIN STOCKS

MANHATTAN, Kan. March 31, 2025 - Kansas **corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2025 totaled 324 million bushels, up 20% from 2024, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 110 million bushels are stored on farms, unchanged from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 214 million bushels, are up 33% from last year.

Wheat stored in all positions totaled 251 million bushels, up 58% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 11.8 million bushels are up 69% from 2024, and off-farm stocks of 239 million bushels are up 58% from last year.

Sorghum stored in all positions totaled 108 million bushels, up 58% from 2024. On-farm stocks of 10.0 million bushels are up 69% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks of 97.5 million bushels are up 57% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 65.7 million bushels, up 10% from last year. On-farm stocks of 18.5 million bushels are down 21% from a year ago but off-farm stocks, at 47.2 million bushels, are up 30% from 2024.

Oats off-farm stocks totaled 1.02 million bushels, up 12% from last year.
