KANSAS HEMP ACREAGE

MANHATTAN, Kan. April 17, 2024 - Industrial hemp grown in open areas in Kansas in 2023 totaled 1,090 acres, up 11% from 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Industrial hemp harvested in open areas totaled 650 acres, up 23% from last year. Industrial hemp grown under protection in Kansas totaled 15,826 square feet, a decrease from 86,219 square feet last year.
