KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 2%

MANHATTAN, Kan. April 17, 2025 - Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.34 million cattle on feed on April 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 2% from last year.

Placements during March totaled 430,000 head, up 8% from 2024.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of March totaled 400,000 head, up 3% from last year.

Other disappearance during March totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
