KANSAS CATTLE ON FEED DOWN SLIGHTLY

MANHATTAN, Kan. May 23, 2025 - Kansas feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.29 million cattle on feed on May 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down slightly from last year.

Placements during April totaled 380,000 head, up 3% from 2024.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of April totaled 420,000 head, down 9% from last year.

Other disappearance during April totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
