Week Ending: June 14, 2020

Released: June 15, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 14, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 25 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 14 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 61.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Homer to 74.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Red River. Highs ranged from 84.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Slidell to 94.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Red River. Light to moderate precipitation was reported throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the southeast part of the State with an average of 3.56 inches.
