Week Ending: June 28, 2020

Released: June 29, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 3.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 28, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 16 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 15 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 69.4 degrees Fahrenheit at St. Joseph to 76.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Galliano. Highs ranged from 85.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Jonesville to 90.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Minden. Light to moderate precipitation was reported throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the south central part of the State with an average of 3.77 inches.
