Week Ending: November 1, 2020

Released: November 2, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 1, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 1 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 20 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 42.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Homer to 59.7 degrees Fahrenheit at New Roads. Highs ranged from 58.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Homer to 79.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Jeanerette. Light to moderate precipitation was reported throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the southeast part of the State with an average of 2.52 inches.
