According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 4.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, May 30, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 49 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 51 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 55.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Jonesville to 72.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Galliano. Highs ranged from 82.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Red River to 88.4 degrees Fahrenheit at St. Joseph. Light to moderate precipitation was reported throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the north central part of the State with an average of 2.72 inches.
