Week Ending: June 20, 2021

Released: June 21, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 6.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 20, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 8 percent short, 66 percent adequate, and 26 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 1 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 24 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 66.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Tallulah to 77.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Galliano. Highs ranged from 89.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Slidell to 95.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Minden. Light to moderate precipitation was reported throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the east central part of the State with an average of 4.96 inches.
