Week Ending: August 14, 2022

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 14, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 9 percent very short, 25 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 17 percent very short, 18 percent short, 55 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus.
