Week Ending: August 28, 2022

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 0.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 28, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 3 percent short, 23 percent adequate, and 73 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 10 percent short, 44 percent adequate, and 45 percent surplus.
