







According to the 2022 Census of Agriculture, there were 128 acres of Arkansas land used for strawberry production, which is a jump from the 2017 Census, where only 88 acres of land were used.



The Mississippi poultry industry had a total of 2,826 operations throughout the state, with a head count of over 132 million chickens.





Ninety seven percent of Arkansas cattle farms are family owned and operated with an average beef cow herd size of around 45 beef cows per farm.




According to the 2022 U.S. Census of Agriculture, Mississippi ranks #1 in the U.S. for Aquaculture production.




The crawfish industry is important in Louisiana.

Census, crustacean sales generated \$131 million in revenue in Louisiana.



According to the 2022 U.S. Census, Soybeans were the top crop in Arkansas with over 3.2 million acres harvested.




As of December 31, 2022, Mississippi had 124,374,849 broilers and chickens in the state.



The equine industry is an important component of agriculture in the Delta Region. According to the 2022 Census of Agriculture there were 19,680 farms with horses in the Delta Region (Arkansas had 7,585, Louisiana had 5,931, and Mississippi had 6,164). There was a total of 104,165 horses on farms in the Delta Region (37,835 in Arkansas, 34,652 in Louisiana, and 31,678 in Mississippi).



According to the 2022 U.S. Census, Corn for grain was 1 out of 5 of Arkansas' top crops in acres with 724,199 acres.





As of December 31, 2022, Mississippi had 117,541 hogs and pigs in the state.


