According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 13, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 33 percent short, 54 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 23 percent very short, 19 percent short, 57 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 2 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 4 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 28 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 8 percent short, 83 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus.
