## Minnesota Ag News – Monthly Prices

The average price received by farmers for **corn** during March 2025 in Minnesota was \$4.45 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service - Agricultural Prices report. This was 2 cents below the February price but 19 cents above March 2024.

The March 2025 average price received by farmers for soybeans, at \$9.61 per bushel, was 26 cents below the February price and \$1.69 below the March 2024 price.

The March average **spring wheat** price per bushel, at \$5.20, was 76 cents below February and \$1.29 below March 2024.

All hay prices in Minnesota averaged \$101.00 per ton in March. This was \$2.00 below the February price and \$41.00 below the March 2024 price. The March 2025 alfalfa hay price, at \$109.00, was \$6.00 below the previous month and \$43.00 below March 2024. The average price received for other hay during March was \$73.00 per ton. This was \$7.00 below the February price and \$42.00 below March last year.

The average price for milk was \$21.80 per cwt, \$2.10 below the February price but \$2.30 above March 2024. Prices received for milk cows for dairy herd replacement averaged \$2,810 per head as of April 1, 2025.


