Week Ending: December 8, 2019

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 4.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, December 8, 2019. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 10 percent short, 54 percent adequate, and 36 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 8 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 31 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 30.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Philadelphia to 46.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi. Highs ranged from 51.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Tupelo to 64.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Columbia. Mild precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the upper delta part of the State with an average of 1.04 inches.

What few blueberries our county has are in a holding pattern trying to keep them healthy during winter months."
