Mississippi Crop Progress and Condition

Week Ending: November 1, 2020

Released: November 2, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 3.6 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 1, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 20 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 9 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 16 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 46.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Lambert and University to 59.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Hattiesburg. Highs ranged from 60.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Lambert to 76.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Hattiesburg. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the south central part of the State with an average of 4.58 inches.
