Week Ending: November 8, 2020

Released: November 9, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 6.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 8, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 11 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 12 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 33.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Winona to 58.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi. Highs ranged from 66.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Tupelo to 74.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Laurel. Minimal precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the southwest part of the State with an average of 0.08 inch.
