Week Ending: November 15, 2020

Released: November 16, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 6.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 15, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 20 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 16 percent short, 71 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 41.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Winona to 64.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Hattiesburg. Highs ranged from 61.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Clarksdale to 80.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Hattiesburg. Minimal precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the east central part of the State with an average of 0.23 inch.
