Week Ending: November 22, 2020

Released: November 23, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 6.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 22, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 29 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 25 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 31.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Winona to 47.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi. Highs ranged from 65.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Tupelo to 76.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Belzoni. Minimal precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the central and southeast part of the State with an average of 0.03 inch.
