According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 1.1 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 13, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 45 percent adequate, and 55 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 44 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 65.5 degrees Fahrenheit at University to 76.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Biloxi. Highs ranged from 79.3 degrees Fahrenheit at University to 89.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Columbia. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the north central part of the State with an average of 14.31 inches.
