Week Ending: June 27, 2021

Released: June 28, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, June 27, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 15 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 18 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 10 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 15 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 60.3 degrees Fahrenheit at University to 77.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Clarksdale. Highs ranged from 84.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Macon to 94.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Laurel. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the coastal part of the State with an average of 3.61 inches.
